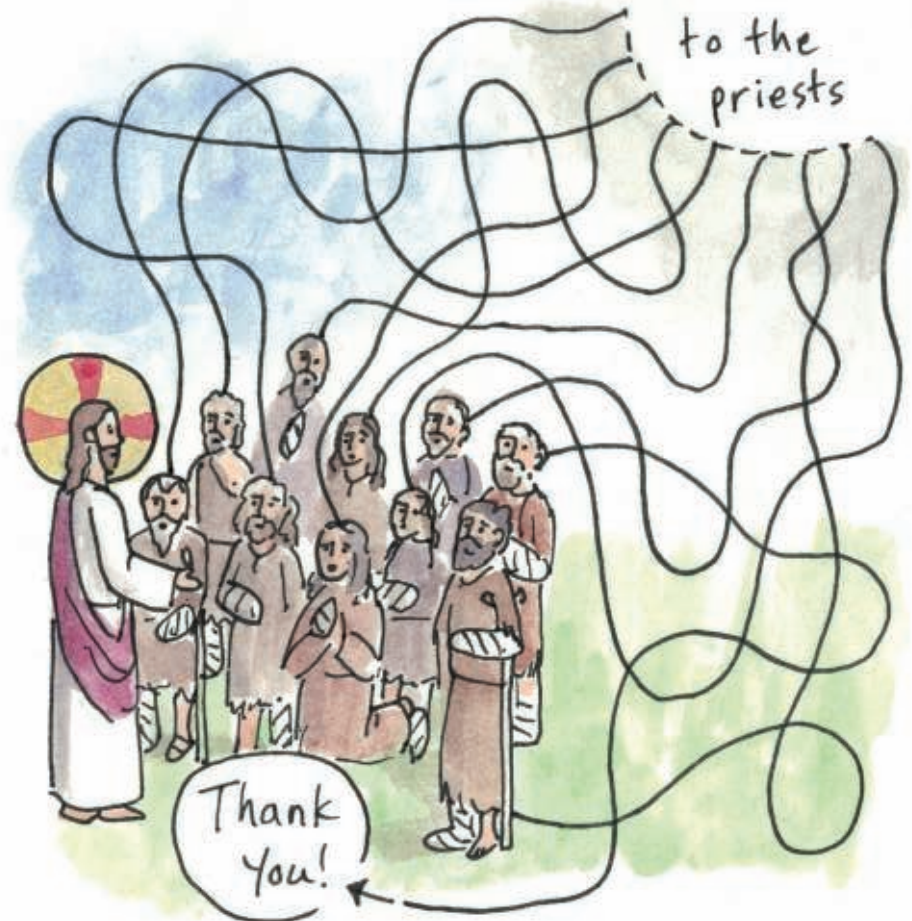
Put on your \_\_\_  \_\_\_ [RNPOA] and wait on me
